Amended 216-2003 An emergency ordinance amending Section 1749.01 of the Building & Housing Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid to restrict the unit size in the building of new homes. (Sponsored by Councilman Lisy by request of Building Commissioner) Vetoed. Ord. 207-2003

This would require 2,000 sq. ft. minimum for new home construction.

217-2003 11. A resolution adopting the rate of each tax necessary to be levied both inside and outside the ten-mill limitation, as certified by the Cuyahoga County Budget Commission. (Sponsored by Mayor Oyaski and entire Council) Res. (581-03)
