- 46-2006** 1. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Building Commissioner of the City of Euclid to enter into a contract, after obtaining three informal quotes, for the demolition of the structure located at 24150 Euclid Avenue, Euclid, Ohio, Permanent Parcel No. 650-30-005, to be in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Building Commissioner and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 1703.50-1703.56 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid, and Sections 715.26(B) and 715.261 of the Ohio Revised Code. (Sponsored by Mayor Cervenik by request of CS&ED Director) Ord. (076-06)
- 47-2006** 2. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Community Services and Economic Development of the City of Euclid to execute a Personal Service Agreement, attached as Exhibit A, for the period of March 21st, 2006, through and including March 21st, 2007, with John Bogert to provide building and plumbing inspection services at a cost not to exceed Twenty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000.00) for the contract period. A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to execute an Agreement by and between the City of Euclid and the Civilian Uniform Police Personnel Organization (CUPPO), as exclusive bargaining agent for all Police Dispatchers and Police Records Room Clerks. An ordinance amending the Business Regulation and Taxation Code, Part Seven of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid to provide for the appointment of the three member Board of Review for matters coming from the collection of municipal income taxes.
