<b>Passed 9-0 1-2010</b>	1. An emergency ordinance amending the Business Regulation Code of the City of Euclid to establish business regulations on exhibition halls within the City of Euclid. (Sponsored by Mayor Cervenik)	Ord. (020-10)
<b>Passed 9-0 2-2010</b>	2. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service of the City of Euclid to enter into a contract with Statewide Ford, 1108 West Main Street, Van Wert, Ohio 45891, for the purchase of three (3) 2010 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors and one (1) 2010 Ford Explorer for use in the Police Department, at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$112,000.00). The vehicles will be purchased through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program. (Sponsored by Councilman Wojtila by request of Service Director)	Ord. (021-10)

(Sponsored by Councilwoman Scarniench)	Ord. (022-10)
<b>Sent to Exec. &amp; Fin. Com. 5-4</b>	4. An ordinance providing for the submission to the electorate of the City of Euclid, the question of whether Article III, Section 2, Recall, of the Charter of the City of Euclid shall be amended to require a declaration of intent to petition for the removal of any elected officer of the City; to impose a 45 day time limit on the filing of petitions; and to increase the number of signatures needed to file such petitions to 25% of the electors voting in the most recent general election.
