An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to issue the 2015 Neighborhood/Tenant/Condominium Association Grant.

WHEREAS, the amount of the grant allocated to each association for the year 2015 will be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00); and

WHEREAS, in 2014, 23 associates participated in the grant program, allowing for increased association activity and outreach efforts to members; and

WHEREAS, to be eligible for the grant, associations must: (1) have had at least three activities and/or meetings in 2014; (2) submit a 2014 financial statement and a mission statement along with their completed grant application; (3) have a bank account in their name and require two signatures for withdrawal.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Euclid is hereby authorized to issue the 2015 Neighborhood/Tenant/Condominium Association Grant. Allocation is in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) each, and to be eligible for the grant associations must: (1) have had at least three activities and/or meetings in 2014; (2) submit a 2014 financial statement and a mission statement along with their completed grant application; (3) have a bank account in their name and require two signatures for withdrawal.

Section 2: Funds to pay for this expenditure are to be derived from the General Fund.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to execute an Agreement by and between the City of Euclid and the Ohio Council 8 and Local 2509 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, (AFSCME 2509) as exclusive bargaining agent for non-management and clericals employees assigned to Streets and Sewers, Public Buildings and Traffic Signals and Signs, to be effective January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4117, negotiations were held between the City of Euclid and AFSCME 2509, to determine equitable compensation, benefits, working hours, and other employment matters for employees assigned to Streets and Sewers, Public Buildings and Traffic Signals and Signs, to be effective January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the new contract include a one and a half percent (1½%) hourly rate increase for the period of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015; a two percent (2%) increase effective January 1, 2016; and a two percent (2%) increase effective January 1, 2017, with equity adjustments for certain categories in 2016 and 2017; and

WHEREAS, employee monthly contribution for health care costs will increase April 1, 2015, with wellness discounts, co-insurance and mandatory generic and mail order prescriptions and a tobacco-use surcharge beginning January 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the contract contains a provision that requires adjustment to the employee contributions for health care coverage should the IAFF agreement receive more favorable terms; and

WHEREAS, other non-economic language changes will be made to clarify current contract provisions; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of the Agreement between the City of Euclid and AFSCME 2509, to be effective January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017, have been ratified by the members of the collective bargaining unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Euclid be, and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute an Agreement by and between the City of Euclid and the Ohio Council 8 and Local 2509 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, (AFSCME 2509), covering the period from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017.

Section 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a Municipal Right of Way Agreement with Crown Castle NG East, LLC, for the placement of communication equipment in the public right of way.

WHEREAS, Crown Castle owns, maintains and operates fiber based communications equipment for the use of its customers; and

WHEREAS, Crown Castle has identified a need for data capacity in the area of Chardon Hills School; and

WHEREAS, an agreement with Crown Castle would establish the framework for the limited use of the public right of way for installation of ground equipment; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance is necessary for the improved data capacity in an area of the community that is presently underserved and is necessary for the good and welfare of the residents of the area served and constitutes an emergency'

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Euclid is hereby authorized to enter into a Municipal Right of Way Agreement with Crown Castle NG East, LLC, substantially in form of the draft agreement on file with the Clerk of Council and as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Euclid, and provided it receives the two-thirds vote of all members of Council elected thereto, shall be in full force and effect from after it passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
