An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid (lessee) to enter into a master lease agreement with Danyaal Holdings, LLC (property owner), for a term of one (1) year at 22050-22056 Lakeshore Blvd, Euclid, OH, Permanent Parcel Number 642-11-003 for the purposes of subleasing the 4 storefronts to eligible entrepreneurs participating in the Recast City program.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that securing these downtown storefronts shows the City's continued commitment to supporting small scale manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor believes that it is necessary for the city to secure these commercial spaces to offset the risk to the property owner taking on nascent stage businesses with less than typical assets and experience; and

WHEREAS, the proposed lease shall cost the City \$43,522 per year and/or \$3,626 per month, of which each sublessor shall pay to the City of Euclid a portion of the amount due based on their individual space, square footage and separate negotiated agreements; and

WHEREAS, the proposed lease between the lessee and property owner shall start on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month immediately following the City's issuance of a certificate of occupancy. At the terminus of the one (1) year it is anticipated that each of the sublessees will enter into independent leases with said property owner in accordance with the proposed expectations of the Recast City program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Euclid is authorized to enter into lease with Danyaal Holdings, LLC, for a term of one (1) year at 22050-22056 Lakeshore Blvd, Euclid, OH, Permanent Parcel Number 642-11-003 for the purposes of subleasing the 4 storefronts to eligible entrepreneurs participating in the Recast City program.

Section 2: That the funds to pay for the one (1) year lease shall be derived from the Cares Act CV3 Grant awarded to the City of Euclid.

Section 3: That the lease agreement shall be in a form as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 142-2020 WHICH MAKES THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR ALL EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF EUCLID FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021.

WHEREAS, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF EUCLID, IT IS NECESSARY THAT THE FOLLOWING SUMS OF MONEY, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS MAY BE NEEDED OR DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY, BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE CORPORATE PURPOSES AND OBJECTS OF SAID CITY AS HEREINAFTER SPECIFIED.

WHEREAS, THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS ORDINANCE CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY IN THAT THE SAME PROVIDES FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC PEACE, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF EUCLID, AND FOR THE DAILY OPERATION OF A MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUCLID, THE STATE OF OHIO.

**SECTION 1 : THAT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF EUCLID, OVER A PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021. THE FOLLOWING SUMS BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY SET ASIDE AND APPROPRIATED AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH.**

**SECTION 2 : THAT THE EXPENDITURES OF EACH FUND FOR THE CITY OF EUCLID CAN NOT EXCEED THE APPROPRIATION AS AMENDED, FOR THAT FUND.**

**SECTION 3 : THAT THERE BE AND THERE IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM THE FOLLOWING FUNDS, THE DETAIL OF WHICH IS SHOWN BELOW:**

**SECTION 4: THAT THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO DRAW HIS WARRANTS FROM ANY OF THE FOREGOING APPROPRIATIONS UPON RECEIVING PROPER CERTIFICATES AND VOUCHERS THEREFORE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF OFFICERS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO APPROVE THE SAME, OR AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL TO MAKE THE EXPENDITURES PROVIDED THAT THE CONTINGENCIES CAN ONLY BE EXTENDED UPON APPROVAL OF TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF COUNCIL FOR ITEMS OF EXPENSE CONSTITUTING A LEGAL OBLIGATION AGAINST THE CITY OF EUCLID AND FOR OTHER THAN THOSE COVERED BY THE OTHER SPECIFIC APPROPRIATIONS MADE HEREIN.**

**SECTION 5: THAT ALL APPROPRIATIONS EQUAL TO OUTSTANDING ENCUMBRANCES SHALL AT YEAR END CARRY FORWARD TO THE NEXT SUCCEEDING YEAR, SHALL NOT LAPSE AND THEREFORE, ENCUMBRANCES NEED NOT BE REAPPROPRIATED.**

**SECTION 6: THAT IT IS FOUND AND DETERMINED THAT ALL FORMAL ACTIONS OF THIS COUNCIL CONCERNING AND RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE WERE ADOPTED IN AN OPEN MEETING OF THIS COUNCIL. AND THAT ALL DELIBERATIONS OF THIS COUNCIL AND OF ANY OF ITS COMMITTEES THAT RESULTED IN SUCH FORMAL ACTIONS, WERE IN MEETINGS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, IN COMPLIANCE WITH ALL LEGAL REQUIREMENTS INCLUDING SECTION 121.22 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.**

**SECTION 7: THAT THIS ORDINANCE IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE NECESSARY FOR THE**

IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF EUCLID, AND PROVIDED IT RECEIVES THE TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS OF COUNCIL ELECTED THERETO, SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL; OTHERWISE TO BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW.

An emergency ordinance amending the City of Euclid Codified Ordinances to reflect the boundary changes in the wards as required by Article II, Section 1 of The Charter of the City of Euclid, Ohio.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 1 of the Charter of the City of Euclid requires amendment to the ward boundaries in the City of Euclid, as described in Euclid Codified Ordinances, to reflect changes in population as determined by the Federal census decennially taken; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State certified the census results on September 21, 2021 and Euclid City Council must amend the ward boundaries within sixty (60) days per the Article II, Section 1 of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this ordinance constitutes an emergency in that the same provides for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the Citizens of the City of Euclid, and for the daily operation of a municipal department and in order to comply with the City of Euclid Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Section 105.02 “First Ward” of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

**SECTION 105.02 FIRST WARD**

The First Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of Euclid Avenue at its intersection of the corporation line of the City of Cleveland;

Thence: Northerly along said corporation line to its intersection with the northerly right of way line of the Norfolk and Western Railroad;

Thence: Easterly along said northerly right of way line, said line also being the corporation line between the City of Euclid and the City of Cleveland, to the centerline of East 219<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 219<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to the intersection with Highland Road;

Thence: Southerly along Highland Road to its point of intersection with the Euclid Creek;

Thence: Southeasterly along the centerline of the East Branch of Euclid Creek to its intersection with the corporation line of the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Southerly along the City corporation line to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue, which is the place of beginning.

Section 2: That Section 105.03 “Second Ward” of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

**SECTION 105.03 SECOND WARD.**

The Second Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of East 200<sup>th</sup> Street at its intersection with the centerline of Naumann Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Naumann Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 215<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 215<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of Ivan Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Ivan Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 232<sup>nd</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along East 232<sup>nd</sup> Street through its prolongation to its intersection with the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway to its intersection with the centerline of Babbitt Road;

Thence: Southeasterly along the centerline of Babbitt Road to its intersection with the centerline of Rockwell Drive;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Rockwell Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Heritage Drive;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of Heritage Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Beverly Hills Drive;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of Beverly Hills Drive to its intersection with Glenbrook Boulevard;

Thence: Easterly along Glenbrook Boulevard to its intersection with Chatworth Drive;

Thence: Southerly to the intersection of the corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Westerly along the southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights to its intersection with the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights continuing to its intersection with the centerline of the East Branch of Euclid Creek;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of the East Branch of Euclid Creek to its point of confluence with the centerline of Highland Road;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of Highland Road to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 219<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 219<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the Norfolk and Western Railroad;

Thence: Westerly along the Norfolk and Western Railroad to its intersection with the centerline of Chardon Road;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of Chardon Road to its intersection with the centerline of the westerly corporation limit of the City shared with the City of Cleveland;

Thence: Northerly along the westerly corporation limit of the City shared with the City of Cleveland to its intersection with the centerline of St. Clair Avenue;

Thence: East on the centerline of St. Clair Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 200<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 200<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of the westerly corporation limit of the City shared with the City of Cleveland;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of the westerly corporation limit of the City shared with the City of Cleveland to its intersection with the centerline of East 200<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 200<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with Naumann Avenue, which is the place of beginning.

Section 3: That Section 105.04 "Third Ward" of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

**SECTION 105.04 THIRD WARD**

The Third Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning in the centerline of Babbitt Road with its intersection of the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway to its intersection with the City of Wickliffe corporation line;

Thence: Southerly along the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Wickliffe to its intersection with southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Westerly along the southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights to its intersection with the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Southerly along the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights to its intersection with the southerly corporation of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Westerly along the southerly corporation of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights to its intersection with the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Southerly along the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights to its intersection with the southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights;

Thence: Westerly on the southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Richmond Heights to its intersection with centerline of Chatworth Drive;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of Chatworth Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Glenbrook Boulevard;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Glenbrook Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of Beverly Hills Drive;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Beverley Hills Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Euclid Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Euclid Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Heritage Drive;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of Heritage Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Rockwell Drive;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Rockwell Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Babbitt Road;

Thence: Northwesterly along the centerline of Babbitt Road to its intersection with the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway, which is the place of beginning.

Section 4: That Section 105.05 "Fourth Ward" of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 105.05 FOURTH WARD**

The Fourth Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of East 185th Street at the southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Cleveland;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 185th Street and its prolongation to the shore of Lake Erie;

Thence: Northeasterly along the shore of Lake Erie to its intersection with the centerline of East 201st Street;

Thence: Southeasterly along the centerline of East 201st Street to its intersection with the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard;

Thence: Northeasterly along the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 208th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 208th Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Lakeshore Boulevard;



Thence: Easterly along the centerline of South Lakeshore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 215th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 215th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Naumann Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Naumann Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 213th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 213th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Arbor Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Arbor Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of E 200th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 200th Street to its intersection with southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Cleveland;

Thence: Westerly along the southerly corporation line of the City shared with the City of Cleveland to its intersection with the centerline of East 185th Street, which is the place of beginning.

Section 5: That Section 105.06 "Fifth Ward" of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 105.06 FIFTH WARD**

The Fifth Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the shore of Lake Erie at the northerly prolongation of the centerline of East 201st Street;

Thence: Easterly along the shore of Lake Erie to its intersection with the centerline of East 242nd Street, now vacated;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 242nd Street to its intersection with the centerline of Lakeshore Boulevard Drive;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Lakeshore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 238th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 238th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Farringdon Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Farringdon Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Williams Avenue;

Thence: Southerly and westerly along the centerline of Williams Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Gay Street;

Thence: Southwesterly along the centerline of Gay Street to its intersection with the centerline of Babbitt Road;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of Babbitt Road to its intersection with the centerline of Fox Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Fox Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Clearview Drive;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of Clearview Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Fox Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Fox Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 222nd Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 222nd Street to its intersection with the centerline of Maydale Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Maydale Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 215th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 215th Street to its second intersection South Lakeshore Boulevard;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of South Lakeshore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 208th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 208th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard;

Thence: Southwesterly along the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 201st Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline East 201st Street and its northerly prolongation to its intersection with the shore of Lake Erie, which is the place of beginning.

Section 6: That Section 105.07 "Sixth Ward" of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 105.07 SIXTH WARD**

The Sixth Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the shore of Lake Erie at the northerly prolongation of the centerline of East 264<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Easterly along the shore of Lake Erie to its intersection with the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the Cities of Willowick and Wickliffe;

Thence: Southerly along the easterly corporation line of the City shared with the Cities of Willowick and Wickliffe to its intersection with the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway to its intersection with the centerline of East 260th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 260th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 264th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 264th Street and its prolongation to its intersection with the shore of Lake Erie, which is the place of beginning.

Section 7: That Section 105.08 "Seventh Ward" of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 105.08 SEVENTH WARD**

The Seventh Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the shore of Lake Erie at the northerly prolongation of the centerline of East 242<sup>nd</sup> Street, now vacated;

Thence: Easterly along the shore of Lake Erie to its intersection with the northerly prolongation of the centerline of East 264th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 264th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Lake Shore Boulevard to its intersection with the centerline of East 260th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 260th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Helen Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Helen Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 256th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 256th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Marsdon Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Marsdon Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 250th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 250th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Shoreview Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Shoreview Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 245th Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 245th Street to its intersection with the prolongation of Wildwood Drive;

Thence: Westerly along the prolongation of Wildwood Drive through the centerline of Wildwood Drive to its intersection with the centerline of East 241st Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 241st Street to its intersection with the centerline of Elmwood Drive;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Elmwood Drive to its intersection with the centerline of East 238th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 238th Street to its intersection with Lakeshore Boulevard;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Lakeshore Boulevard to its intersection with East 242nd street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 242nd Street and its northerly prolongation to the shore of Lake Erie, which is the place of beginning.

Section 8: That Section 105.09 "Eighth Ward" of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid of the General Provisions of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Euclid is hereby amended and replaced to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 105.09 EIGHTH WARD**

The Eighth Ward shall contain all that territory bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of East 215th Street at its intersection with the centerline of Ivan Avenue;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 215th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Maydale Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Maydale Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 222nd Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 222nd Street to its intersection with the centerline of Fox Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Fox Avenue to its first intersection with the centerline of Clearview Drive;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of Clearview Drive to its second intersection with Fox Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Fox Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Babbitt Road;

Thence: Northwesterly along the centerline of Babbitt Road to its intersection with the centerline of Gay Street;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Gay Street to its intersection with the centerline of Williams Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Williams Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Farrington Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Farrington Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 238th Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 238th Street to its intersection with the centerline of Elmwood Drive;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Elmwood Drive to its intersection with the centerline of East 241<sup>st</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 241<sup>st</sup> Street to its intersection with the prolongation of Wildwood Drive;

Thence: Easterly along the prolongation of Wildwood Drive through the centerline of Wildwood Drive to its intersection with the centerline of East 245<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 245<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of Shoreview Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Shoreview Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 250<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 250<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of Marsdon Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Marsdon Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 256<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 256<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of Helen Avenue;

Thence: Easterly along the centerline of Helen Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 260<sup>th</sup> Street;

Thence: Southerly along the centerline of East 260<sup>th</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway;

Thence: Southwesterly along the centerline of the Lakeland Freeway to its intersection with the centerline of the prolongation of East 232<sup>nd</sup> Street;

Thence: Northerly along the centerline of East 232<sup>nd</sup> Street to its intersection with the centerline of Ivan Avenue;

Thence: Westerly along the centerline of Ivan Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of East 215<sup>th</sup> Street, which is the place of beginning.

Section 9: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 10: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Euclid, and provided it receives the two-thirds vote of all members of Council elected thereto, shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
