1. An emergency ordinance, for the benefit of the Euclid Municipal Court, authorizing the Mayor or her designee to enter into a Managed Services Agreement with DataServ Integrations, LLC dba DataServ, 31280 Viking Parkway, Westlake, Ohio 44145, for three (3) years at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Fifty-Six Cents (\$257,673.56) during said three (3) year contract period. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail)

2. An ordinance declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, describing the public improvements to be made that directly benefit such parcels, requiring the owners of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes, and establishing a Euclid Avenue TIF District #2 public improvement tax increment equivalent fund for the deposit of such service payments, and declaring an emergency. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilpersons Tanner and Tolton) (Referred to Euclid Avenue

**Comment: This would create a Tax Increment Financing District on Euclid Avenue that would use funds generated from the district for public improvements.**

3. A resolution authorizing the Director of Finance of the City of Euclid to take advances on the collection of Real Estate Taxes, Personal Property Taxes, and Special Assessments. (Sponsored by All Members of Council by request of the Director of Finance) Res. (137-24)

**Comment: This would allow the Finance Director, for fiscal year 2025, to take advances of certain tax payments collected by the Cuyahoga County Treasurer.**

4. An emergency ordinance amending Ordinance No. 108-2024 which makes the annual appropriations for all expenditures for the City of Euclid for the period ending December 31, 2024. (Sponsored by Council President Mancuso by request of the Director of Finance) Ord. (138-24)

**Comment: This would amend the 2024 budget.**

5. An emergency ordinance enacted by the City of Euclid, Cuyahoga County, Ohio hereinafter referred to as the MUNICIPALITY, in the matter of the resurfacing of Richmond Road from the Southern Corporation Line to Brush Road in the City of Euclid and requests the cooperation of the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, with financial assistance for said project, and authorizing the Mayor, or her designee, to execute all documents and agreements necessary to receive and expend said assistance from the COUNTY. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail) Ord. (141-24)

**Comment: This would authorize the execution of an agreement with Cuyahoga County to accept \$250,000.00 for a project that will resurface Richmond Road.**

6. A resolution confirming the Council of the City of Euclid's election of \_\_\_\_\_ as President of Council to fill the vacant position effective January 1, 2025 and \_\_\_\_\_ shall serve the balance of the unexpired term ending on December 31, 2025. (Sponsored by All Members of Council) Res. (139-24)

**Comment: This would elect the new Council President who would begin serving in that role on January 1, 2025.**
